Intermediate+ course through
the Work Welsh scheme at
Nant Gwrtheyrn Language Centre

Residential week: 24/11/25 - 28/11/25



This course is for staff working within the health or social care sector in Wales. Individuals who attend will need to be able to speak Welsh at Intermediate+ level but would like more practise and support to be confident in using their Welsh at work. There will be workshops with specialist tutors and plenty of opportunities to enjoy practising speaking Welsh.

A programme of activities through the medium of Welsh will support the learning, including yoga and mindfulness and entertainment in the evenings.

Learners on this course are expected to be able to participate in a conversation in Welsh about day-to-day issues or on familiar topics. They are expected to have some specialist vocabulary or terms for their work.
