**Please see below a summary of the various levels:**

## Entry

Suitable for complete beginners or for those who have completed a Welsh taster course. The emphasis is very much on conversational Welsh. You will learn basic patterns, greetings and vocabulary and will be able to hold a basic conversation using the present, past and future tenses by the end of Entry level.

## Foundation

The Foundation course is for learners who have successfully completed the Entry Level or for those who have some basic knowledge of the Welsh language including patterns in the past, present and future tenses.

## Intermediate (Equivalent to GCSE)

Suitable for those who have already completed Entry and Foundation or those who are already quite comfortable with the basic patterns of the language such as past, present, future, and conditional (i.e. "I would"). The emphasis is still on speaking but more writing, reading, and listening will be introduced. Learners should be able to discuss every day issues fairly easily by the end of this level.

## Advanced (Equivalent to AS Level)

This course aims to raise the learner's confidence to hold conversations and to write contemporary issues. There will also be opportunities to practise specific grammatical points and patterns in order to create more complex sentences.
