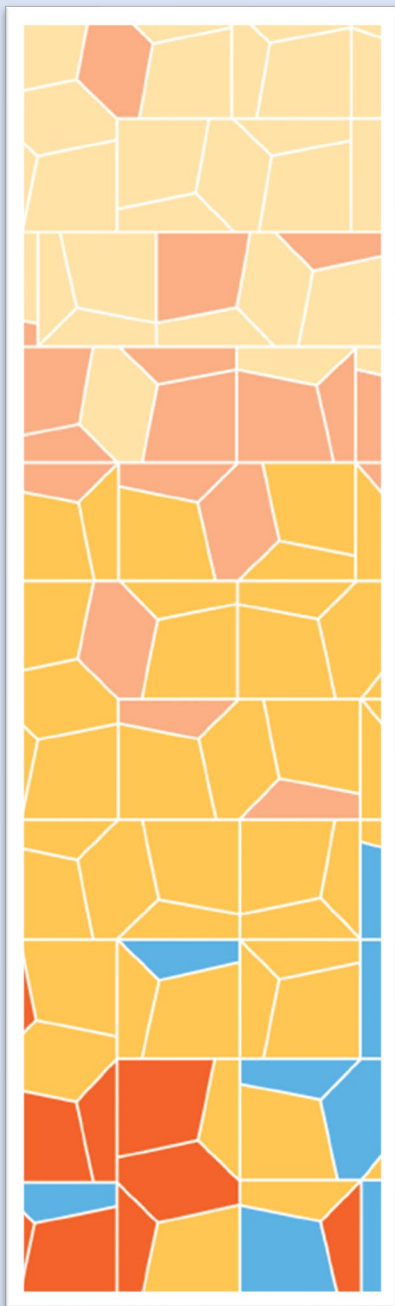

Beth yw Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Canolradd?

Arholiad wedi fwriadu'n bennaf ar gyfer oedolion sy'n dysgu Cymraeg ar lefel ganolig. Does dim *rhaidd* sefyll arholiad er mwyn dysgu Cymraeg, ond mae'n rhoi rhywbeth i chi anelu ato ac yn eich helpu i wella'ch sgiliau iaith. Does dim rhaidd sefyll arholiad arall cyn gwneud Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Canolradd.

Beth yw'r lefel?

Dyma'r drydedd lefel y gellir sefyll arholiad arni. Mae'r arholiad yma'n addas i ymgeiswyr sydd wedi gorffen Cwrs Canolradd neu sydd ar lefel debyg. Mae'r cymhwyster hwn yn cyfateb i lefel B1 yn fframwaith Ewrop (CEFR).

Ydy hi'n bosib sefyll y prawf Siarad yn unig?

Rhaid i chi wrando ar fwletin newyddion ac ateb cwestiynau'n seiliedig arno.

Rhaid i chi ateb y cwestiynau yn Gymraeg. Fyddwch chi ddim yn colli marciau am gamgymeriadau, ond rhaid i chi ddangos eich bod chi wedi deall yr eitemau.

2.i Siarad (Tasg Sgwrsio) 15%

Rhaid i chi recordio un sgwrs gyda rhywun sy'n siarad Cymraeg yn rhugl, (nid eich tiwtor). Dylai'r sgwrs bara tua 5 munud. Cyflwynwch eich hun a'r person arall ar y dechrau, yna rhaid i **chi** arwain y sgwrs, **gofyn y cwestiynau ac ymateb i beth mae'r person arall yn ei ddweud**. Dych chi'n gallu holi'r person am unrhyw beth, e.e. gwaith, bywyd cymdeithasol, diddordebau, yr ardal, teulu. Prawf Siarad 'Ar-lein'

Byddwch chi'n derbyn 'taflen yr ymgeisydd' gan eich canolfan arholi 30 munud cyn amser penodedig y prawf. Cyn dechrau'r prawf ar-lein, bydd rhaid i chi ddangos ID ffotograffig i'r cyfwelydd, er mwyn cadarnhau pwy ydych chi.

Mae 2 ran i'r prawf Siarad. Bydd y marcwyr yn asesu eich gallu i siarad yn gywir, amrywio amserau, i ryngweithio â'r cyfwelydd, priodoldeb y sgwrs, ynganu, a'r gallu i estyn ymatebion.

ii. **Trafod pwnc**

3. **Darllen a Llenwi Bylchau** 15%

Mae 3 rhan i'r prawf yma, sy'n para 60 munud:

- i. **Erthygl**
Rhaid i chi ddarllen erthygl ac ateb cwestiynau a fydd yn crynhoi'r prif bwyntiau.
- ii. **Negeseuon e-bost**
Rhaid i chi ddarllen 2 neges ar ffurf e-bost. Bydd cwestiynau amlddewis i ddangos eich bod chi wedi deall y darnau a bwriadau'r ysgrifenydd.
- iii. **Llenwi Bylchau**
Rhaid i chi lenwi bylchau mewn darn neu ddeialog estynedig.

4. **Ysgrifennu** 15%

- i. **Llythyr**
Rhaid i chi ysgrifennu llythyr tua 100 o eiriau o hyd ar destun penodol. Mae dewis o destunau.
- ii. **Llenwi Ffurflen**
Rhaid i chi lenwi ffurflen, e.e. holiadur, yn gofyn am tua 150 o eiriau.

Asesir eich gallu:

- i ysgrifennu'n gywir
- i ddefnyddio ystod o batrymau a geirfa
- i gyflawni'r dasg

Pryd mae'r arholiad?

Cynhelir y profion i gyd ar ddiwrnod penodol. Ni chaniateir i ymgeiswyr sefyll yr arholiad ar amserau gwahanol i'r rhai a nodir.

Bydd y papurau yn y drefn yma, yn dechrau am 9.15 y bore:

Darllen a Deall, a Llenwi Bylchau	60 munud
Gwranddo a Deall	tua 50 munud
Ysgrifennu	75 munud
Y Prawf Siarad	tua 20-25 munud

Cynhelir y Prawf Siarad ar amser penodol yn y prynhawn, ar ôl toriad am ginio. Bydd eich canolfan arholi'n cadarnhau lleoliad yr arholiad ac amcan o amser eich prawf Siarad cyn yr arholiad ei hun.

Canlyniadau

Byddwch chi'n cael eich marciau ar gyfer pob prawf tua wyth wythnos wedi diwrnod sefyll yr arholiad, ac yn derbyn eich tystysgrif tua diwedd mis Medi. Os byddwch chi'n sefyll y prawf Siarad yn unig, byddwch chi'n derbyn datganiad cyrhaeddiad. I lwyddo, rhaid i chi gael 60% o'r marciau posibl fel arfer; i gael Rhagoriaeth, rhaid i chi gael 80% o'r marciau posibl. Mae'r union ffiniau'n cael eu pennu mewn cyfarfod dyfarnu.

Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Canolradd 2026

What is Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Canolradd?

An exam intended primarily for adults who are learning Welsh at an intermediate level. You don't *have* to sit an exam to learn Welsh, but it does give you something to aim for, and will help you improve your language skills. You don't have to sit another exam before taking Defnyddio'r Gymraeg: Canolradd.

What is the level?

This is the third level at which you can sit an exam. This exam is suitable for learners who have finished Cwrs Canolradd or who are on a similar level. This qualification corresponds to B1 level in the European framework (CEFR).

Is it possible to take the Speaking test only?

Yes. You'll receive a statement of attainment, not a full qualification. When you register with your exam centre, you must let them know that you wish to take the Speaking test only. You will not be able change the registration later. If you *have* taken the Speaking test at this level already, it's possible to take the other tests (Reading, Writing and Listening) in order to complete the qualification. **Speaking test marks may be carried forward for one year only.** If you wish to do this, you must let your exam centre know when you register.

When will this take place?

It will be possible to sit the exam on this date:
Friday 12 June 2026

By when do I need to register?

For the summer exams, you must register by 27 February 2026.
Late registrations will not be accepted.

How much does the exam cost?

Contact your local Learn Welsh provider for information about the fee.

How do I register?

All candidates must register with their 'Learn Welsh' provider. You are responsible for this, not your tutor. You can not register directly with WJEC. The contact details are at the end of this document.

Candidates who speak Welsh as a first language are not permitted to sit this exam. Candidates who have received most of their education through the medium of Welsh are not permitted to sit this exam, unless they have left school for at least five years.

Neither WJEC nor exam centres can guarantee that the exam will be available in your area.

There are several parts to the exam, testing the language skills you are learning in your Welsh class.

More details

1. Listening 15%

There are 2 parts to this test. You'll hear both three times.

i. Dialogue

You must listen to a dialogue and answer questions based on it.

ii. News bulletin

You must listen to a news bulletin and answer questions based on it.

You must answer the questions in Welsh. You won't lose marks for errors, but you must show that you've understood the items.

2.i Speaking (Conversation Task) 15%

You must record a conversation with someone who speaks Welsh fluently (not your tutor). The conversation should last around 5 minutes. Introduce yourself and the other person at the start, then **you** must lead the conversation, **asking questions and responding to what the other person says**. You may ask the other person about anything, e.g. work, social life, interests, the area, family. The markers will assess your ability to interact, to ask questions and the accuracy of your language.

You must record the conversation in an electronic format (mp3 is recommended). If you're unsure how to do this, contact your examination centre.

**Send your conversation task to your examination centre.
Do not send your task directly to WJEC.**

Do not stop the conversation and restart – it should be uninterrupted. Do not script the conversation beforehand. You will lose marks if you do this.

Send your file to your examination centre by 1 May 2026.

2.ii **Speaking Test** 40%

The test usually lasts around 20-25 minutes.

The test will be recorded and assessed externally. Do not register unless you are willing to be recorded in this way.

The speaking test may be held online. If so, it will be recorded using the teaching platform used by your provider (e.g. Zoom or MS Teams). **Your exam centre will decide how the Speaking test will be held.**

‘Face-to-face’ Speaking test

You will be given the candidate’s sheet at the start of the test and have 30 minutes to prepare one of the discussion topics. It’s possible to take the candidate’s sheet into the interview room, but do not try to script what you wish to say.

‘On-line’ Speaking test

You will receive the candidate’s sheet from your exam centre 30 minutes before the specified time of the test.

Before starting the online speaking test, you will have to show the interviewer photographic ID to confirm your identity.

There are 2 parts to the Speaking test.

ii. Topic discussion

The interviewer will ask which topic you’ve chosen, and will talk to you about the topic for around 5 minutes.

iii. General conversation

The interviewer will ask you questions about your background, work, family, interests, experiences learning Welsh, holidays or any topic which crops up during the course of the conversation.

You will be assessed on your ability:

- to speak accurately
- to use a range of patterns and vocabulary
- to respond appropriately
- to pronounce Welsh
- to extend responses

3. **Reading and Gap-filling** 15%

i. **Article**

You must read an article and answer questions which summarise the main points.

ii. **E-mail messages**

You must read two e-mail messages. There will be multiple-choice questions to test if you've understood the messages and the writers' intentions.

iii. **Gap-filling**

You must fill in the gaps in a text or extended dialogue.

4. **Writing** 15%

i. **Letter**

You must write a letter of around 100 words on a specific topic. There is a choice of topics.

ii. **Form filling**

You must fill in a form, e.g. a questionnaire, of around 150 words.

You will be assessed on your ability:

- to write accurately
- to use a range of patterns and vocabulary
- to fulfil the task

When is the exam?

The tests will all be held on one specific date. No candidate will be allowed to sit the exam at times other than those noted.

The papers will be in this order, starting at 9.15am:

Reading Comprehension and Gap-filling	60 minutes
Listening Comprehension	approx. 50 minutes
Writing	75 minutes
Speaking Test	approx. 20-25 minutes

The Speaking Test will be held at a designated time in the afternoon, after a lunch break. Your centre will confirm the location of the exam and time of your speaking test before the exam itself.

Results

You will receive your marks for each test approximately eight weeks after sitting the examination, and will receive a certificate usually at the end of September. If you only take the Speaking test, you will receive a statement of attainment. To pass, you usually need to attain 60% of the possible marks; to attain Distinction, you need to get 80% of the possible marks. The exact grade boundaries are decided at an award meeting.
